



Notice of Review of Communities and Electoral Arrangements Draft Proposals

In accordance with the relevant sections of the Local Government Act 1972, Monmouthshire County Council is conducting a review of the communities and electoral arrangements throughout Monmouthshire.

The review will consider the need to create, merge or abolish existing communities and whether there is a need to split the community into wards for separate representation within the community. The review will also consider the number of councillors to represent the community and, where warded, the number of councillors per ward.

The Council have formulated its draft proposals for the communities based on the Terms of Reference for the review and representations received during the initial consultation period. Copies of the draft proposals are available to view at Council Offices and Libraries. The draft proposals have also been published electronically available from www.monmouthshire.gov.uk.

The Council welcome receipt of representations to the published draft proposals to assist with the preparation of the final recommendations. Representations must be received by 28th February 2014.
